



2024 CALIFORNIA SAUVIGNON BLANC

BRIGHT. CRISP. IRRESISTIBLY LAYERED.

This vibrant Sauvignon Blanc is a lively blend of hillside vineyards from two standout North Coast appellations—Sonoma County (71%) and Lake County (29%). The Sonoma portion brings an explosion of zesty citrus and fresh herb aromas, giving the wine its signature brightness and zip. From the high-elevation vineyards near Guy's Ranch in Lake County, come lush notes of honeydew melon and ripe pear, along with a silky, rounded mouthfeel that perfectly balances the crisp acidity. The result? A Sauvignon Blanc with mouthwatering freshness, layers of juicy fruit, and a smooth, lingering finish that speaks with a North Coast accent—and it's saying: pour another glass.
